

Important information:

Do your part and properly dispose of waste - You can help keep neighbourhoods clean and safe by properly disposing of waste and reporting abandoned garbage or illegal dumping to panp-wardens@pc.gc.ca.

Please do not abandon waste beside the waste bins in the community. Please do not dispose of residential construction waste in the waste bins in the community. Doing so is a violation of the National Parks of Canada Garbage Regulations under the Canada National Parks Act and may damage the equipment. Violators can be charged and face court appearances and fines. Costs associated with addressing abandoned waste are charged back to the community.

The “Roll off bin” is a seasonal receptacle for residential construction waste. It is located on the Operations Centre grounds. All material must be put **in** the bin, do not leave materials on the ground. This bin is not intended for the disposal of construction waste from commercial properties.

Hours of Operation— hours are posted at bin. The area is monitored by video camera.

Open daily 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. from May long weekend to September long weekend.

Open weekdays 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. after September long weekend until Thanksgiving.

What can I put in the Roll Off Bin?

- Small construction materials from residential properties (windows and frames, deck boards, dry wall, carpet, treated and non-treated scrap wood)

What do I need to find alternate disposal methods for?

- Mattresses and household furniture (sofas, tables, chairs)
- Propane tanks, gas, fuel, oil, solvent products, paint containers (empty or with paint), fluorescent tubes and batteries
- Household appliances (washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, microwaves and water heaters)
- Electronic equipment and electric wire
- Concrete and rocks
- Dead animals
- Brush and leaves – please take this to the staging area
- Refundable cans and bottles, cardboard boxes, office paper and newspapers, clean plastic containers, milk jugs, sheet plastic, metal – please take these to appropriate recycle bins in town.
- Household garbage – please put this in designated garbage bins
- Hazardous materials – DDT (a pesticide) or other hazardous materials - please email the sanitation supervisor at panpassets@pc.gc.ca to arrange drop off at Operations Centre
